This is San Diego Bay taken from the crest of Point Loma, 422 feet above the water. The Naval Base is in the center, the Naval Air Station is on Coronado Island on the right, and if you can make out the piers that are beyond the Naval Base, that is where the Navy trains sea mammals to do odd jobs.

NOTE the brownish haze just above ground level at the horizon - locals claim it's smog that blows in from Los Angeles.
