This trip is over now.

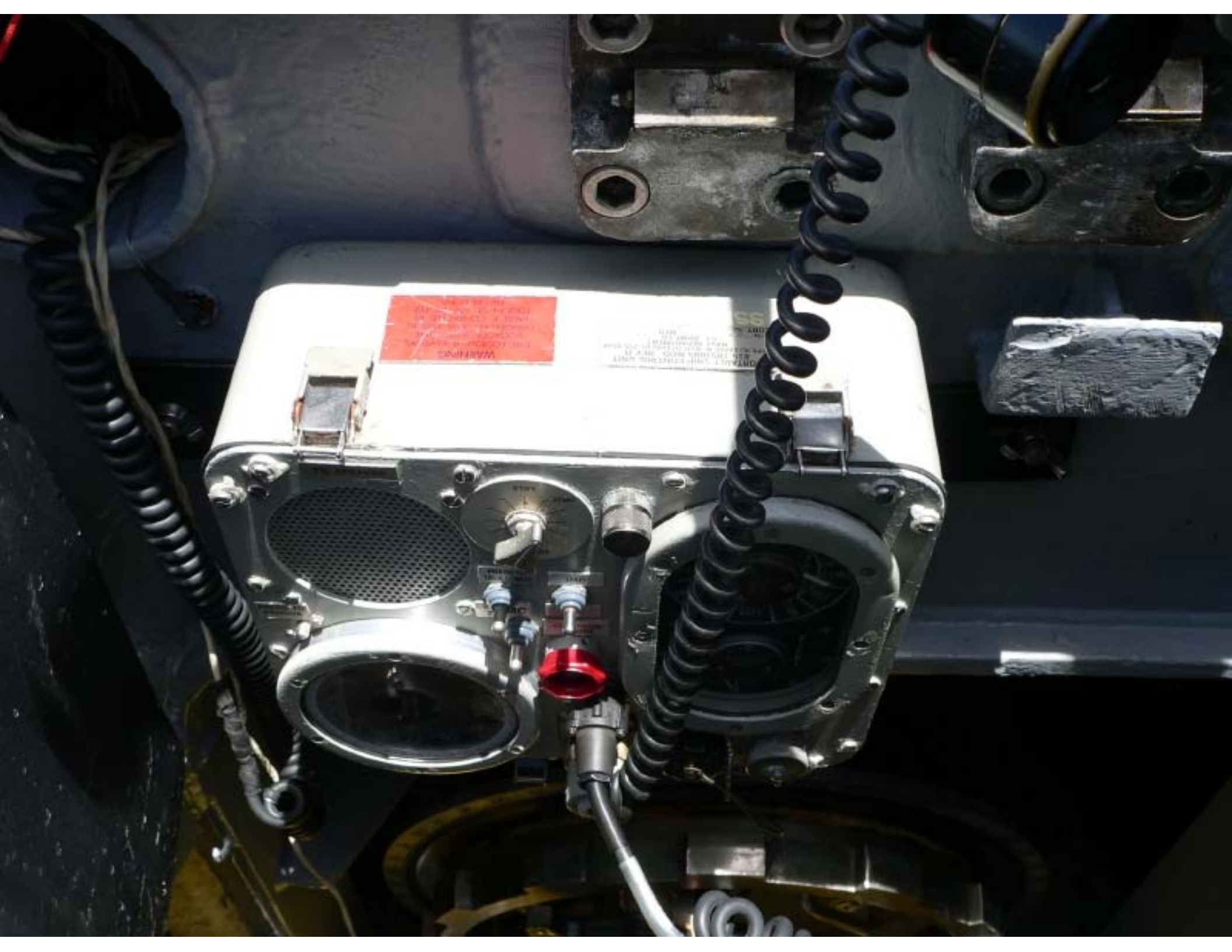
