Today I had to go out on to Resurrection Bay to a small inlet of sorts, called Thumbs Cove, on the F/V Captain Cook (see map). Of course, I had AlaskaCAM situated inside the cabin looking forward. It's different from previous time-lapse videos because the vessel was rock'n'rolling. But it does show some of the beauty in the area, as well as the weather.

We started shortly after sunrise (which occurred at about 9:35AM), and anchored in the cove for several hours while we worked (don't ask!). As the day progressed, it started to turn sour. While we were preparing to return to port, it began to snow. It was difficult to keep the cabin window clear for AlaskaCAM, but when we reached the piers, it cleared up enough to see again.

I can't even describe the view. There was one mountain on the edge of Thumbs Cove where the underlying ice of a glacier was visible (in other words, it wasn't covered with snow) and the light blue color of the ice was a stark contrast to the white-white snow. I tried to capture it in a picture (slightly left of center in picture 7a) but without the sunlight it just didn't come out.

Also attached are some of the pre-sunrise views of Seward, and other shots of Resurrection Bay. Enjoy.

Tomorrow I will be driving back to Anchorage. Along the way, I plan on visiting Whittier. One reason is to go through the Whittier Tunnel, and the other is to say I've actually been to Whittier (and lived to tell about it).
