Hello.

I've been out and about a lot the past few months, but I haven't been able to squeeze out any postcards.

I recently returned from my third visit to Virginia Beach in as many weeks. No pictures, but I installed BeachCAM® on the inside of the window of the tenth floor, ocean front room I occupied. It was running for three days, capturing one frame every 10 seconds, and is played back at 30 frames per second. In other words, 1 second of video equals five minutes of time.

Just North of my hotel (to the left in the video) is the entrance to the Chesapeake Bay. Many ships can be seen on the horizon at all times of the day and night.

The surrounding area is home to many military bases. Occasionally, training exercises are conducted off the coast of Virginia Beach, and BeachCAM happened to catch some on the last evening, through most the night. Try to spot the hovering helicopters at sunset. Attached is a single frame from the event.
